Then complete the worksheet 'phonics read and write' or write the sentences on a piece of paper. Ask your child to sound out the missing words by themselves and write these words down at the end of the correct sentence.
- 2. Please go back over all 'Where can GG sit?' new words.
- 3. Please go back over sounds keyring every day if it is in your child's folder. Jolly phonics sounds on you tube will also help revise sounds. You can find the video <u>HERE</u>.
- Please log into your getepic account <u>CLICK HERE</u> and read the books I have assigned to you.
- 5. This week our new words will be our tricky words. The children are used to learning TRICKY WORDS with me. We call them passwords and they normally say them before they go to the toilet. We just learn them by the shape of the word. The best way to learn them is for you to write the word on a big sheet of paper and stick it somewhere in the house. Every time your child passes this word they will remember it. We try and do one word a day or whatever your child can manage. Please go to the 'Tricky Words' worksheet on the next page of this document. Let's concentrate on words 1-5 this week.
